<p style="text-align: center;">Philippian Jailer</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">“Sirs, what must I do to be saved?” (Ac 16:30)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">“<u>Believe</u> on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.” (Ac 16:31)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>UNBELIEVER</b></p> <p>The jailor had not yet believed the message of the gospel. The first step in obeying the gospel is to believe.</p> <p>The gospel was preached to the jailor and he obeyed it (Ac 16:32-33).</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Jews on Pentecost</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">“... Men and brethren, what shall we do?” (Ac 2:37)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">“... <u>Repent, and be baptized</u> ... for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.” (Ac 2:38)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>BELIEVER</b></p> <p>The Jews heard Peter’s sermon (Acts 2) and believed.</p> <p>Having already believed, they were commanded to repent and be baptized.</p>

Lord, what wilt thou have me to do?” (Ac 9:6)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">“What shall I do, Lord?” (Ac 22:10)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">“... arise, and <u>be baptized</u>, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.” (Ac 22:16)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PENITENT BELIEVER</b></p> <p>Paul already believed and repented. He spoke to the Lord on the Damascus road and expressed a penitent attitude. He prayed to God and fasted (Ac 9:9,11).</p> <p>The only thing Paul lacked was being baptized.</p>
